The 2025 HKMS Young Scholars Award – Call for Nomination

The purpose of the Hong Kong Mathematical Society Award for Young Scholars is to recognize outstanding achievements of young scholars who are working in the institutions in Hong Kong not exceeding the age of 45 in the fields of pure and applied mathematics, and statistics. All submissions will go through a formal evaluation process by a panel of established scholars.

Submissions will be assessed by the following criteria:

- Significance of results
- Originality of work

Eligible candidates for the Award are full time faculty members working in the institutions in Hong Kong not exceeding the age of 45 on January 1st of the year of award with the major work done in Hong Kong in the fields of pure and applied mathematics and statistics. The candidates should submit a statement describing the research, a CV with birthday displayed therein, and up to three representative articles. In principle, the representative articles should have been published or accepted by referred journals at the time of submission. The candidates should arrange three reference letters sent directly by the referees.

The policy of the nomination is

- 1. President/vice presidents of the HKMS, department heads, and full time full professors (or higher) working in an institution in Hong Kong, can nominate at most one candidate each year.
- 2. The nominators, whose nominee failed to be awarded, will be asked whether they are interested to nominate the candidate again. If so, the nominee will be asked to update his/her application.
- 3. Each candidate can have only one nominator.

Submissions must be received no later than 17 Mar 2025 for full consideration. All materials must be submitted electronically to the HKMS general secretary HUA Zheng at huazheng@maths.hku.hk
